

Disability Access



Our top tips for oral health

1. Brush twice a day with a fluoride toothpaste
2. Don't rinse with water or mouthwash after brushing
3. Clean between your teeth, fillings, crowns and bridges at least once a day with floss or interdental brushes
4. Electric brushes are proven to remove more plaque than traditional brushes
5. If you notice bleeding from your gums, mention it at your dental health check
6. Avoid smoking or chewing tobacco products, these have a significant risk of causing oral cancer.
7. Smile, it's free and may make somebodies day!

Services we offer

At Bath Street we are happy to be able to provide services for our patients, both under the NHS system or privately funded.

What will my treatment cost?

Whether you are a privately paying patient, or have your treatment subsidised by the NHS, we will provide you with a treatment plan with an estimate of the costs involved prior to starting treatment. There is an up-to-date copy of our private and NHS fees available at the reception desk and on our website.

Appointments and emergency services

We make every effort to see our patients at the appointed time, however if you are kept waiting there is usually a good reason and so please be patient and know that we will be with you as soon

as we are able. On cancelling or changing appointments we ask that you give us as much notice as possible. Cancelling with less than 24 hours notice or missed appointments may incur a charge. If you repeatedly miss appointments or cancel at the last minute, unfortunately we will no longer be able to treat you as a patient.

If you need to be seen urgently, then phone the practice as early in the day as possible and we will strive to see you as soon as possible. If your emergency is out of normal opening hours, there will be a recorded message on the answerphone giving details on how to be seen.

Confidentiality

Strict confidentiality of patients' records and information is maintained at all times. Patient records will not be passed on to any third parties
